- 3. Adoption of Agenda

- 5. Constitution and Bylaws
 - a) Abiding with Constitution and Bylaws

- b) Amendments and Discussion
 - Amendments to the constitution and bylaws were discussed and wording finalized. The updated documents will be sent to franchise centres to vote on

and the updated documents will be posted on the website prior to the November 1 start of the season.

- Discussion included the U9 and U11 year-end tournaments. Hague volunteered to host a U11 tournament on March 18 with another centre to be determined. Langham, Wakaw, Aberdeen and Cudworth volunteered to host a U9 tournament on March 11. Hosting centres will be confirmed at a later date.

 - Dalmeny moved to adopt the 2021-22 Financial Statement, Rosthern seconded the motion, all were in favour. Carried

 - Scott Coulson spoke on behalf of Dundurn Minor Hockey who was requesting to become a franchise centre.
 - Dundurn representatives left the room, discussion ensued, followed by the vote. Current franchise centres voted with a majority opposed to Dundurn becoming a franchise centre.
