COVID – 19 Rules & Regulations

1. Mandatory Face Covering
 - Anyone entering Wakaw Jubilee Arena **MUST** have a face covering:
Non-medical mask which covers the face and nose
 - Players must keep their face covering on until they put their helmets on
 - Coaches must keep their face covering on until they put their helmets on to head to the ice surface
2. **All skaters & spectators must sign-in** & sanitize hands upon entry & follow social distance guidelines at all times
3. Spectator Capacity
 - Maximum capacity is 80 provided there is enough room to maintain two meters of physical distancing between extended household groups – side to side & front to back
 - Members of extended households must sit together, with a minimum of two meters between extended household groups
 - Spectator visiting, moving around and congregating is strongly discouraged
 - Spectators should not be within two meters of players as they enter/exit the ice surface or dressing rooms
4. Dressing Room Use
 - Dressing rooms will be assigned on board when entering building, please use assigned rooms only
 - No showering in dressing rooms
 - Please pick up all garbage in rooms before leaving
5. Anyone presenting with COVID-19 symptoms are NOT permitted to enter the rink
6. Arrive no more than 30 minutes before scheduled ice time & leave no more than 20 minutes after scheduled ice time.
